The Network is open for organisations

- who shares the objectives
- who is 'not for profit'-organisations
- who has a significant volunteer basis
- whose work is knowledge based and transparent
- who has no economic relation with the alcohol industry
- who is tolerant and sensitive to the professional, cultural and spiritual diversity within the self-mutual-help approach and community programmes in Europe
- who is engaged in mutual help programmes or community based programmes as defined in the Objectives in a systematic and comprehensive manner.

The following organisations may apply for membership

- Full membership: national, regional and local organisations fulfilling the above mentioned criteria's. However, if their parent organisations become full members any sub-national membership must be terminated.
- "Associate membership: International organisations, or any organisation fulfilling the above mentioned criteria's but which either are predominantly professional in character or not having a comprehensive mutual help-group programme.
- Associate members
 1. are included in the information network,
 2. have the right to be consulted on policy positions,
 3. may take part and speak at network meetings
 4. may be elected to the board
 5. Associate members do not have the right to vote at the General Assembly.
